



**St. Paul's Outreach Ministry Guidelines
For Social Ministries and World Mission
June 2011**

The Outreach Ministry of St. Paul's is a social ministry that looks beyond the walls of our parish to fulfill Christ's call to love our neighbors as ourselves. As our Lord commanded, we commit our selves, our time and our resources to feed the hungry, protect the weak, and clothe the naked. Jesus reminds us in Matthew 25:40 that "whatever you did for one of the least of these, you did for me."

The Outreach Ministry Team has the responsibility of screening new outreach ministries to determine that they are in line with the St. Paul's vision and the Outreach Ministry's mission. There is a survey available in the office that helps prospective leaders think through the process for a new ministry. Upon receipt of the completed form, the team will make a recommendation to the rector, who will make final approval.

The Outreach Ministry Team meets regularly to disburse funds. Existing ministries that St. Paul's has a history of supporting will be given first priority.

New outreach ministry formation is welcome. Any new outreach requests for financial assistance may be submitted with a written request on forms that are available online or in the church office.

As we continue to work together, we give thanks for the generosity of the parish and for the faithfulness of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
